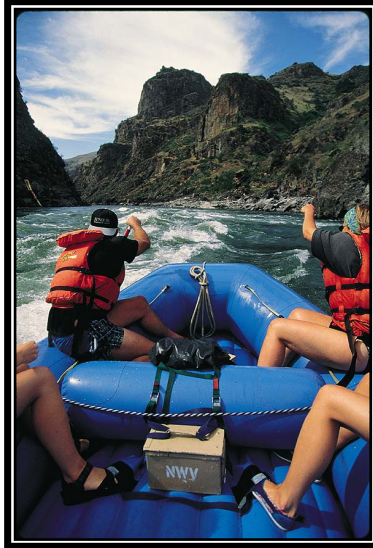

Trip Itinerary

Day 1: Please arrive at the Boise Airport by 4:00 p.m. Transportation is provided to the Little Salmon Lodge in Pollock, Idaho (a 3-hour drive). After settling into our rooms, we will enjoy dinner and our trip orientation meeting to discuss our activities for the week.

Days 2-5: Each of the next four days, after enjoying a hot breakfast at the lodge, we will meet our guides and depart for our activity. Lunch is provided each day during our day's activity. We typically arrive back to the lodge in the late afternoon. We'll have dinner each night at the lodge with the lodge's private chef. The evening offers time to enjoy the lodge's amenities, including a hot tub, beer and wine bar, outdoor and indoor games, and a great local swimming and fishing hole.

Day 6: After breakfast, we head back to Boise. If you plan to fly out on this day, please schedule your flight after 1:00 p.m. Drop-off is also available at Boise hotels if you plan to extend your stay.

Choose from Daily Activities including:

Whitewater Rafting & Kayaking

Rafting on the Salmon River is one of the principle reasons people visit Idaho. Up to three days of rafting different sections of the Salmon are available, including an optional overnight trip with two days of whitewater and one night of camping on a beautiful white-sand beach. The rapids are Class III and are appropriate for both beginners and experienced rafters. You can even choose to follow a guide and run the rapids on your own in an inflatable kayak!



Horseback Riding

Our horseback ride is on top of the Salmon River canyon, with spectacular views of the Seven Devils Wilderness Area, Gospel Hump Wilderness Area and the Salmon River canyon. The trail ride on experienced dude stock is fun and challenging, but is still appropriate for beginners.

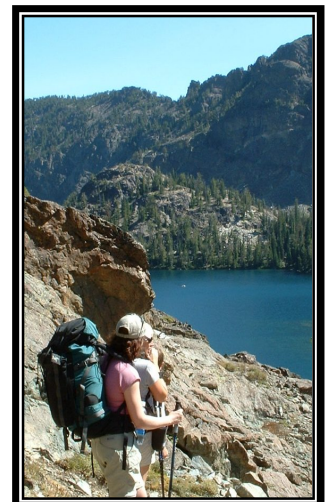


Hiking

Idaho's mountains are impressive and awe-inspiring. Join an all day hike in the Seven Devils Wilderness to high alpine lakes and across rugged mountain passes. Or you can enjoy more leisurely hiking along Rapid River; the nation's first designated Wild and Scenic River. All hikes offer beautiful scenery and guides who will lead the hike at your pace.

Mountain Biking

We'll visit Brundage Mountain Ski Resort to experience lift-assisted mountain biking. Using the ski lifts to get to the top of the mountain, a wide variety of trails from easy to difficult are available for self-guided mountain biking. Enjoy leisurely cruise riding along the rim of the mountains and slowly working your way down the slopes; or embark on any number of steep descents that will get your adrenaline flowing!
